Develop America's Airmen Today ... for Tomorrow

- Airport: KAFF United States Air Force Academy
 - Runway 16L/34R – 3500 x 75’
 - Field Elevation: 6572’ (DA can exceed 9000’)
 - Daylight operations only
 - You must have permission prior to landing at the Academy – see “How to land at the Academy”
- All ground and flight events will be conducted at the Academy
- Practice Days: 03 – 07 Oct
- Contest Days: 07 -10 Oct
- Departures: 11 Oct (AM)

- Fuel (estimated \$3.50 per gallon)
 - Cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express
 - Refuel only at scheduled times
 - You must have a actual person at the aircraft when the truck arrives to refuel
 - No fuel available Sunday 4 Oct or Sunday 11 Oct.
 - Fuel accounts must be closed NLT 1300 Sat 10 Oct

 - SCAN (written test): 1300 – 1400
 - Aircraft ID (written test): 1500 – 1600
 - Computer Accuracy (written test): 1700 - 1800
 - Contest Ends: NLT 10 Oct 1200
 - Awards Ceremony: 10 Oct 1430
 - AF vs. TCU Football Game: 10 Oct 1730
 - Aircraft Depart: 11 Oct 0700 – 1200
