COLONEL COLLIN P. COATNEY

Colonel Collin Coatney is the Air National Guard Advisor to the Commander, Air Education and Training Command, Joint Base San Antonio-Randolph, Texas. In this position, he assists with formulating, developing, and coordinating policies and programs impacting more than 108,000 Air National Guard members. The command operates more than 1,400 trainer, fighter and mobility aircraft, 23 wings, 10 bases and five geographically separated units training more than 293,000 students per year.

Colonel Coatney was commissioned in 1998 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps at Marquette University. Prior to joining the Air National Guard in 2012, he served as a combat-ready F-16 pilot on active duty, which included assignments at Hill AFB and Kunsan AB as well as an assignment as an Undergraduate Pilot Training Instructor at Sheppard AFB. He is a command pilot with more than 3,600 hours, to include over 100 combat hours, and has deployed in support of OPERATION NOBLE EAGLE and OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM.
