Colonel John V. Bartoli is the Inspector General, Headquarters Air Education and Training Command, at Joint Base San Antonio-Randolph, Texas. Members of the command's Inspector General Directorate are responsible for inspecting more than 320 training organizations, encompassing Air University and two numbered air forces, with more than 1,500 aircraft from 23 major design series and over 63,000 personnel. Additionally, the directorate is responsible for the command's Congressional Inquiries Program, the Inspector General Complaints Program, as well as the Fraud, Waste, and Abuse Program.

Bartoli was born in Easton, Pennsylvania. He entered the Air Force in 1997 as a graduate of King's College in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania. He has been assigned to numerous operational and staff positions and has served as an instructor and evaluator in multiple crew positions on the E-3B/S Sentry, wing executive officer, an airpower strategist on the Air Staff, and the commander of Air Combat Command's largest formal training unit and the Air Force's only control and reporting center operations group.
