#### Memorial planned for final WWII Doolittle Raider

**JOINT BASE SAN ANTONIO-RANDOLPH, Texas** – A memorial service to celebrate the life of retired U.S. Air Force Lt. Col. Richard "Dick" E. Cole will be held here Thursday, April 18, 2019, beginning at 3 p.m. in Hangar 41.

Cole, who was the final surviving member of the famed Doolittle Tokyo Raiders of World War II, passed away in San Antonio April 9 at the age of 103.

Cole was the copilot for then-Lt. Col. Jimmy Doolittle in a B-25 Mitchell bomber during the surprise mission on April 18, 1942, by the U.S. Army Air Forces to strike the Japanese Home Islands. The strike was in retaliation for the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor and bolstered American morale in the early months of World War II.

The memorial also marks the anniversary of the Doolittle Raid. Air Force senior leaders, patriots, family and friends are expected to attend. Arlington National Cemetery will be Cole's final resting place.

At the memorial service, hundreds of Airmen will line the main entrance to JBSA-Randolph to salute the family as they enter base. In addition to this tribute, there will be a flyby, missing man formation and serval static aircraft displayed.

Cole's decorations include the Distinguished Flying Cross with two Oak Leaf Clusters, Air Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Bronze Star Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal, and Chinese Army, Navy, Air Corps Medal, Class A, 1st Grade.
