Colonel Merna Hsu is Commander, 381st Training Group, Air Education and Training Command, Vandenberg Air Force Base, California. The group provides initial training for the nation's space and Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) operations and ICBM and air-launched cruise missile maintenance forces. In addition, the group provides training to Air Force Global Strike Command and Air Force Space Command senior staff, and instructor enhancement to support operational wings.

Colonel Hsu entered the Air Force in 1996 as a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy. Her assignments have included duties as an evaluator, instructor, weapons officer, deployed Combat Operations Division Space Cell Chief, Special Technical Operations Deputy Chief, and strategic and operational planner.
